#### ELECTION TIME TABLE

National Secretary Paddy Crumlin reports that preparations for the conduct of the 2015 Quadrennial Elections are continuing to progress. Following is a partial extract of the Election Timetable which sets out the key dates in the process.

Members should be aware that the following important dates will apply:

- Postal Ballot Opens Tuesday 28 April 2015;
- Nominations for Offices to be filled at a Quadrennial Election shall Open 12.00am Friday 6
   March and close 5.00pm Tuesday 7 April 2015
- Application for Absentee Vote Closes 5:00pm Tuesday 9 June 2015;
- Postal Ballot Closes 5:00pm Monday 15 June 2015;
- Counting of Ballot commences Tuesday 16 June 2015;
- Declaration of the Poll before Wednesday 1 July 2015.

Please note some of these dates have had to be changed due to Rule 43(d) of the MUA Rules and the clash of weekends and Public Holidays.

To ensure maximum participation in the postal vote, members should ensure that the relevant Branch Office has -

- correct residential/postal address, and
- should ensure their financiality is current and will be so during the election process.

If unsure or uncertain, members are urged to contact their Branch Office immediately.

Members will also be advised by notices on the MUA Webpage and by SMS contact concerning the need to ensure they are financial and to ensure correct contact details are advised to their Branch Office.
