Brisbane Ferries: Vote YES for protected action

THE MUA QLD Branch is stepping up its campaign in support of our members at Transdev Brisbane Ferries. The company's intimidation and stalling tactics over the past eighteen months have left us with no option but to apply to the Fair Work Commission for a Protected Action Ballot (PAB).

Transdev's current offer is simply not good enough. A four percent pay rise over the life of the agreement is not good enough. Overtime starting after 40 hours of work a week instead of kicking in after a 7.6 hour shift is not good enough. An unfair tiered system is not good enough.


"All we want is a fair go for Ferry workers. We urge all MUA members at Brisbane Ferries to vote YES for legal, protected industrial action".

The MUA's application for a PAB is now in the process of being approved by the Commission. All current financial MUA members at Brisbane Ferries will receive their ballots in the mail in the next week or two [if you are unsure of your financial status, check with the Branch - (07) 3395 7215].

The industrial action currently planned by the union includes no collection of fares and not turning ticket machines on; no wearing of uniforms; no training of new employees; no working of dual duties and bans on shift extensions and overtime.

It is important to stress that the planned action will not cause any disruption to commuters. All current services will continue. The target of this action is Transdev's revenue – not the public.

All we want is a fair go for Ferry workers. We urge all MUA members at Brisbane Ferries to vote YES for legal, protected industrial action.



Hutchison dispute hits the 70 day mark

TODAY (October 15) marks the 70th day of the long-running Hutchison dispute. On August 6, at a half an hour before midnight, Hutchison Ports sacked 97 workers by text & email. Hutchison is owned by the Asian billionaire Li Ka-Shing.

The community assembly in Brisbane is still in place. All MUA members are encouraged to make the trip to Curlew Street, Berth 11 Fisherman Island to show your support for our sacked MUA members.
