## **Protest of Partnerships in Mackay**

IAN BRAY EXPRESSED his disgust with BMA entering into Partnership Arrangements in Towage at Hay Point outside the office of local MP George Christensen. BMA are attempting to destroy all Fair Work conditions by offering Partnerships eliminating sick leave, superannuation, annual leave, unfair dismissal and personal leave etc - all conditions we currently defend by negotiating as a collective.

Partnerships do not have the ability to negotiate conditions under the Fair Work Act as they

are not classed as an employee/employer relationship.
